



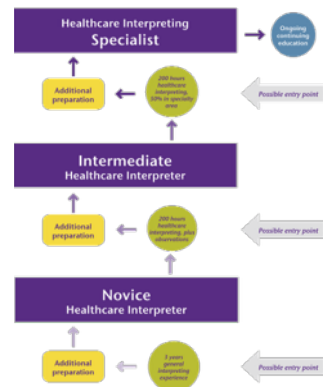

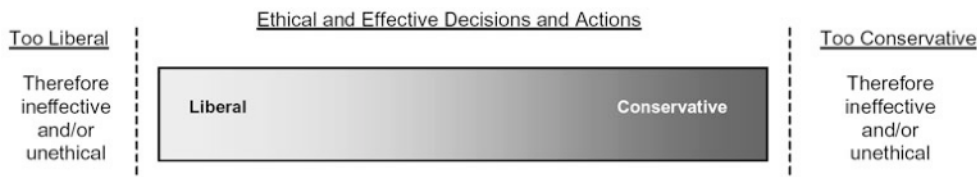


Healthcare Interpreter Career Lattice
